

How To View The ‘For Those In Peril’ Map Files

These maps are saved as kmz files. In order to view them you will have to have the Google Earth app loaded onto your mobile device. You may also need a live internet connection for it to work. Once you have downloaded and unzipped the folder called ‘For Those In Peril Mobile Maps.zip’, open the folder you extracted it to and you will see a list of maps. Each map provides information on where the events in each chapter took place. Different colours are used to represent information about different groups of people. If you click on a dot, you will bring up a text box with information about what happened in the book at that location. To view a map in Google Earth, click on it’s name in the folder. This should open Google Earth and display the map for that chapter. To open another map at the same time, go back to the folder and click on it’s name without closing your Google Earth app. To display only one map at a time, close your Google Earth before you open the next map file.

If you find you have any problems viewing these maps on your device, it may be that you need to download and install another app to allow you to display the KMZ files. If you’re running an Android OS, an app called KMLZ to Earth Explorer works for many devices.
